Closings

All City of Altamonte Springs offices, parks and programs will remain closed for business on Tuesday, September 12.

Storm Cleanup & Trash Collection

The City of Altamonte Springs has suspended trash collection starting today, September 11. Garbage and recycling collection will resume when conditions allow.

Post Storm Debris Removal Tips:

- Residents should pile tree limbs, debris, etc. at the curb on public right of way (generally this is between the road and sidewalk) and not in the street for collection.
- Keep storm debris separate from other waste (e.g. normal household garbage).
- Separate vegetative storm debris from construction related debris.

Storm Damage Permit & Inspection Changes

The City's Building Fire Safety Division has made the following temporary changes to the permit and inspection processes to facilitate the recovery efforts from Hurricane Irma:

- Electrical service and meter change-out inspections can be requested and performed on the same day.
- Fence replacement is allowed in the same location without a permit as long as the support posts are still in place.
- Arbor permits (tree removal permits) are NOT required to remove storm-damaged trees on one and two-family dwelling properties through October 15.
- Before hiring a contractor, ask to see a Florida state contractor's license. Verify the license number with the [Department of Business and Professional Regulations](#).

Reminder: Roofing and siding repairs 100 square feet or less do not require a permit or inspection.
