CAMP DETAILS

Altamonte Springs Recreation Teen Camp runs for nine weeks. The program includes games, activities and field trips to area attractions and career-oriented trips that provide job shadowing with local professionals. Camp also includes life-skill training in areas such as resume writing, job interviews, budgets and more.

Dates: June 3 – August 2 (No Camp July 4 & 5)

Times: Monday – Friday | 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Early drop off starts at 7 a.m. Late pick up ends at 6 p.m. No extra cost.

Registration and Fees

Open to City residents and non-residents. Participation is limited to 50 teens.

Camp cost is \$450 per teen and is taken in three separate payments. The first payment is processed at the time of registration. The second and third payments are processed on June 1 and July 1. A credit card is required to be on file until receipt of the last \$150 payment. Payments are automatically deducted. Once agreed upon, the parent cannot withdraw from the commitment. Nonpayment will result in the participant's removal from teen camp.

Full Summer Discount: Participant fee paid in full at the time of registration is discounted to \$360 per teen, \$340 per teen for two or \$320 per teen for three or more.

Registration fees do not include field trips or lunch.

Lunch

Participants are required to bring lunch. For those who participate in weekly field trips, lunch is governed according to the rules of that particular attraction.

Field Trips

Each Tuesday, all teens participate in a free, career-oriented field trip. Each Wednesday, there is an optional field trip. These trips are scheduled at local attractions and require additional fees. To participate in field trips, register at www.ASRecreation.org.

Swimming

Weekly swimming is offered throughout the program. Swim times are 2 to 4 p.m. most Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Participants are transported to the Westmonte Recreation Center for swim sessions. To participate, an electronic authorization is required.
