Shooting Suspect Arrested

On 06-16-2012 at 3:51am, the Altamonte Springs Police Department responded to 911 Great Bend Rd, in reference to a male that had been shot at the residence. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the victim, Jeremy Williams, dob 08-14-1980. According to witnesses, Williams and the resident, Christopher Seckington dob 09-07-1959, became involved in a disturbance, at which time Seckington shot Williams in the shoulder area. Williams then barricaded himself in his residence, refusing to come out and speak with officers on scene.

With the assistance of the Seminole County SWAT Team, Seckington was taken in to custody without incident at 7:30am.

Williams was transported to ORMC with non-life threatening injuries.

Seckington was arrested and transported to the Seminole County Jail, where he was charged with attempted murder.

Both Williams and Seckington have an extensive criminal history, involving drugs and have more than 30 combined arrests.
