April 10, 2020 – The City of Altamonte Springs continues to assess and respond to COVID-19 and has issued the following important updates:

- **Effective Friday, April 10, the City of Altamonte Springs has extended the Local State of Emergency by Executive Order for an additional seven days.**
- **The City is canceling ALL events and programs through May 21 at this time.**
- **All City parks are closed until it is safe to reopen the locations.**
- **City offices are closed to walk-in visitors until further notice. Staff is available to assist customers by phone or email.**

All residents must follow the State of Florida Executive Order 20-91 and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention hygiene guidelines:

- Limit movement and personal interactions outside of your home to only those necessary to obtain or provide essential services or activities as defined by the Governor's Executive Order.
- Wear a cloth face covering in public settings where other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain (e.g., grocery stores and pharmacies), especially in areas of significant community-based transmission.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick. If you are sick, stay home and practice "social distancing."
- Avoid gatherings of 10 or more people.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Discard the tissue.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
